## Cricket 2010 starts here.

Once again our winter training will be held at Maplesden Noakes School sports hall. This year we have slightly changed the format of our three sessions so as to include the whole club at the same venue. As part of this we shall also have on display the new club kit and there will be an opportunity to see all of the sizes available and to place your own orders. If ordered in the first two weeks the new kit should be with us for the last session and therefore use for the beginning of the season.

Our winter training this year will take place on six successive Sundays starting on 21<sup>st</sup> February and ending on 28<sup>th</sup> March. The sessions will be run by our own ECB qualified coaches together with help from outside specialist coaches.

The first session will be between 13:15-14:45 and will be for LBJ boys hard ball groups at Under 11, Under 13 and Under 15.

The second session will be between 14:45-16:15 and will be for LBW girls and ladies.

The third session, although some of our own coaches will be present, will not have any formal coaching content and will be for LBCC adult nets from 16:20-17:50. **Any members of LBJ or LBW who may wish to play for any LBCC adult team are welcome to attend these sessions in addition to their earlier one although there will be an additional cost.**

The programme for the first two sessions will include fitness and agility work, group batting, bowling and fielding practice as well as net sessions and some specialist coaching in certain areas. This year we have Paul Farbrace, the Kent first team coach and former Sri Lankan assistant coach coming to lead one of our sessions.

The cost for the winter session will be £25 per child (cheques made payable to LBH Cricket). Places are limited so get your replies in early.

Clothing should be trainers and cricket clothing, tracksuit or something similar. All equipment is provided though you may bring your own equipment if you wish. A helmet must be worn when batting in the nets and for boys a cricket protector (box) also.
